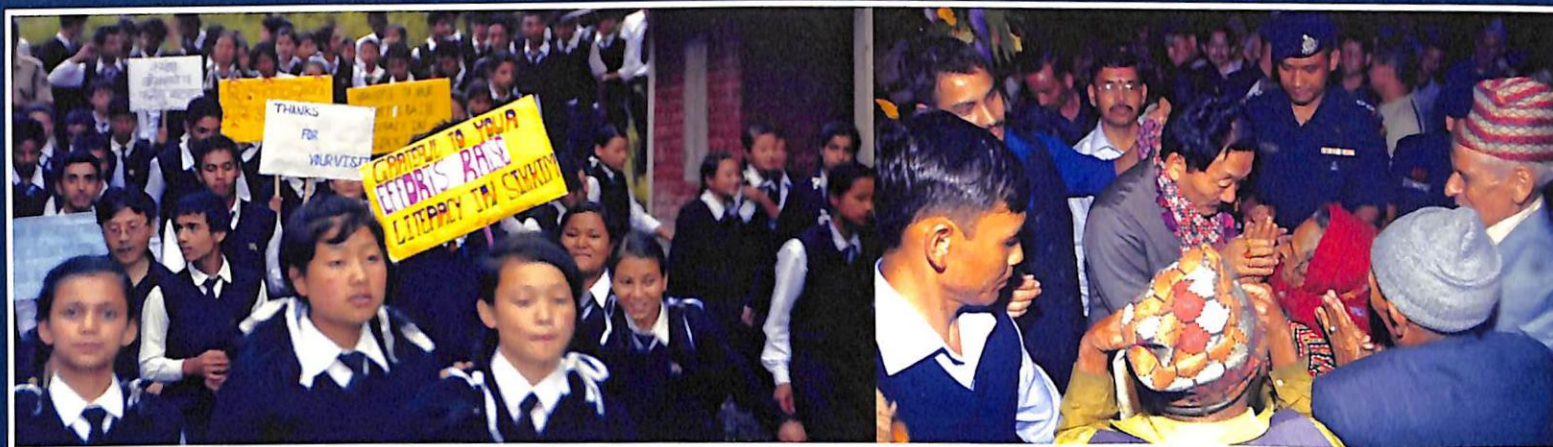


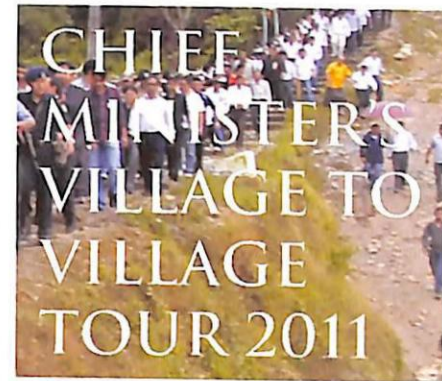

PREFACE

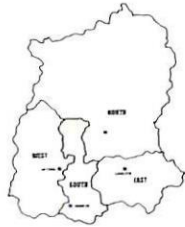
